What is the Ages and Stages Questionnaires: Social-Emotional (ASQ:SE)?

The ASQ:SE-2 is a set of questionnaires about young children's behavior and social-emotional development. There are 9 questionnaires that you can use with your child beginning at 1 month to 6 old.

The ASQ:SE-2 has been used for more than 15 years to make sure children's social-emotional development is on-schedule and to address parent's concerns as early as possible. The ASQ:SE can help identify your child's social-emotional strengths as well as any areas where your child may need support or where you have concerns.

As a parent or caregiver, you are the best source of information about your child. That's why ASQSE-2 questionnaires are designed to be filled out by you. You will only need 10–15 minutes. It's that quick and easy.

Here's how ASQSE-2 works:

- You will answer each question "often or always," "sometimes," or "rarely or never" based on your observations of your child's behaviors.
- You will note if any behaviors are of concern to you.
- Your answers help show your child's strengths and areas where he or she may need support.
- After you complete the questionnaire, your provider will discuss the results with you.

If there are no concerns, there is nothing more you will need to do. If there are concerns, your provider will help you with next steps. Getting support for behavioral concerns as early as possible prevents problem behaviors from getting more difficult as your child gets older.

You play an important role in your child's learning and development. By completing ASQSE-2 questionnaires, you are making sure your child is off to the best possible start!
