### What Is ASQOregon.com?

Free, interactive site that contains Ages and Stages Questionnaires (ASQ), a series of parent completed questionnaires that screen and monitor a child's development between 1 month and 6 years of age. Results help determine if the child's development is on track or if he or she may need further evaluation and/or early services to support development.

- Free, confidential, interactive site for parents/caregivers to check a child's development.
- Designed to increase early developmental screening opportunities in Oregon.
- Public service, pilot project from the Oregon Dept of Education and the Early Intervention Program, University of Oregon

### Parents/caregivers can:

- Complete the Ages and Stages Questionnaires (ASQ) and the Ages and Stages Questionnaires: Social Emotional (ASQ:SE) online in the privacy of home or with support from a provider.
- Receive automatic results; if requested, personal response by email or phone is available.
- Make decisions about any follow-up as suggested in results.
- Share results with childcare provider to help identify strengths and areas that may need practice or support.
- Download play and learning activities to use at home and at school.
- Save information for child and family records.
- Share ASQ results with health care provider at well child checkups.
- Monitor their child's development every 6-12 months.
